

2025 FAIR RULE CHANGES & UPDATES

Fair Board and Extension Board have made a couple of changes to the fair rules for the 2025 Meade County Fair:

- Livestock Weight Requirements
- Rate of Gain Contest (Added rules since there were none previously.)
- Weigh ins
- Air Pistol

See below for specific rules. Please make sure to review these as you plan your 4-H projects for the year.

LIVESTOCK WEIGHT REQUIREMENTS:

The Meade County Fair will now follow the State Fair Grand Drive rules for market livestock weight requirements. The intention is that the Meade County Fair will continue to match State Fair and these weights will remain the same unless the State Fair changes. The age requirements have not changed. Market livestock must meet these requirements to compete for grand & reserve champion, sell in the premium auction, and compete in the Rate of Gain contest.

Species	Weight			
Beef	Minimum of 1000 pounds (Floor buyer reserves the right to set a maximum)			
Swine	230-290 pounds			
Sheep	Minimum 90 pounds			
Goats	Minimum 60 pounds			

RATE OF GAIN CONTEST

The Rate of Gain factors in the Average Daily Gain (ADG= pounds of weight gained/number of days on feed) of an individual animal over the period between spring weigh-in and county fair weigh-in. The rate of gain contest will be held for all animals that were weighed in at the spring weigh-in and the County Fair weigh-in. Animals meeting the qualifications will automatically be entered. Ties will be broken by using the placings from the market show.

To qualify, animals must:

- 1. Be weighed in at both the spring county weigh-in/tagging day & county fair weigh-in. Rate of Gain weigh-ins will not be permitted on make-up tagging dates.
- 2. Be a market animal.
- 3. Be within the specified weight limits for their species.
- 4. Weigh ins must be witnessed by an extension agent and a fair board member or livestock superintendent. 4-H member must be present.

WEIGH INS:

Any 4-Her showing livestock at the county fair must be present at the spring and county fair weigh ins.

While livestock can still go under family names at the spring weigh in, each 4-Her who plans to show any livestock at the county fair must be present. The 4-H project is the responsibility of the 4-H member. If 4-H members are not able to attend the weigh in, you can still schedule a time with Hannah PRIOR to the weigh in to have your animals tagged. (Not new) Each 4-Her must walk THEIR OWN animal across the scale at the county fair weigh in. This is to demonstrate control and to take responsibility for your own 4-H project.

Tentative Weigh in Dates: Beef - March 12th Small Animal - April 27th

Air Pistol (rules added for new division):

Youth shooting air pistol at the county fair must attend at least 2 safety lessons/practices prior to the county fair shoot.

AGE: Must be 12 years old to shoot air pistol. Ages 12 and 13 shoot 2 handed. Ages 14+ shoot 1 handed.


